2011 Goals

I'm still a bit new to 600's and have realised that I need plenty of seat time, so I plan to race as much as possible, attending both WERA and CCS sprint races, and compete in the ASRA Team Challenge series as a team member of RnR Racing.

Racing Highlights

2010 – Attended trackdays across the East Coast to include VIR, Road Atlanta, Summit Point Raceway, and New Jersey Motorsports Park.

2009 – Ended up braking my leg badly at the end of 2008; didn't ride a bike again until late 2009.

2008 – Season with NGRRC (North Gloucester Road Race Club) Formula 400 class; 4th in championship. RAFMSA (Royal Airforce Motorsports Association) novice racer of the year.

- March: Brands Hatch Indy - placed 14th and 12th
- April: Cadwell Park - placed 10th and 6th
- May: Snetterton - placed 4th and 6th
- June: Pembrey - placed 4th and 3rd
- July: Donnington Park - placed 5th and 2nd (novice of the meeting)
- Aug: Pembrey - placed 1st and 2nd
- Sept: Oulton Park - placed 2nd and 1st (lap record in class for 08 and 09)
- Oct: Thruxton - placed 4th and 6th

I've held my race licence in England since 2001. This allowed me to go testing for years on many tracks. I never really thought I'd do well at racing, so I just stuck to the test days on my Kawasaki ZX7RR superbike. The experience allowed me to ride most tracks in the UK, as well as the Nurburgring Nordshleife and Spa Franchorchamps, doing more trackdays and race test sessions than I can remember. In 2007, I decided to buy a 400 race bike and do a proper season's racing.
